CONAP Dri-Purge is an inert dry gas blanket used to displace moisture-laden atmospheric air in opened containers of CONATHANE® polyurethane resins and compounds. It helps to extend the shelf life of moisture sensitive materials. CONAP Dri-Purge is also useful in protecting all moisture sensitive resins from contamination.

Polyurethane resins and curing agents – by their very nature – are moisture sensitive materials. Most resin producers, at the time of manufacture and packaging, apply a blanket of nitrogen gas to containers – immediately before sealing – to exclude all traces of moisture and enable them to guarantee a minimum shelf life (usually 15 months to 18 months). With CONAP Dri-Purge you can repeat this process each time you reseal your moisture sensitive resins.

CONAP Dri-Purge now enables the end-user to greatly extend the shelf life of partially used containers of polyurethane resins and systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

After opening a sealed container of polyurethane resin and/or curing agent, immediately spray CONAP Dri-Purge into the partially used container(s) for 5-10 seconds, then tightly close the lid.

The shelf life of opened containers can now be extended for 15 to 18 months by using CONAP Dri-Purge each and every time the containers are opened!
